

#### SUN. 15 DEC 2024: ARRIVAL - WINDHOEK

## ACCOMMODATION AT HOTEL HEINITZBURG, B+B (1 x COMFORT DOUBLE ROOM)

Flight details: FRA - WDH LH4304 ARRIVAL @ 09:15

Welcome to Namibia! You arrive at Hosea Kutako International Airport. We recommend buying a Namibian SIM card for your phone at the small MTC kiosk near the baggage carousels before the luggage scanner machine. The kiosk staff can give you more information about the data package options and assist you in installing the card on your phone and updating the necessary settings so the card is fully functional. It is currently not possible to use an e-SIM while travelling in Namibia.

A driver from the car rental company, AFRICAR, waits for you as you enter the arrivals hall. The driver will transfer you to the car rental depot in Windhoek. Here, you complete the required paperwork, pay the security deposit (a temporary hold will be placed on your credit card) and receive a detailed briefing about your 4x4 vehicle. After this briefing, you will be ready to start your Namibian self-drive adventure. Drive to Hotel Heinitzburg and check in. Windhoek has numerous good restaurants. We recommend making a reservation if you're interested in dining at Heinitzburg.

Return to Windhoek. Drive to the AFRICAR rental depot to return your car. A driver will transfer you from the depot to the Elegant Guesthouse in Klein Windhoek—dinner as per your arrangements.

Breakfast is included. At 06:30, a driver will pick you up from the guesthouse and transfer you to the airport, where you will check in for your onward flight.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- This trip is not suitable for people with reduced mobility.
- Namibia is experiencing an increase in theft incidents targeting tourists in urban areas. Please
  do not walk at night in Windhoek or Swakopmund. Do not leave any valuables visible in your car
  when you leave it parked in an urban area. Make sure your luggage is stored in the back and not
  visible. Ensure all vehicle doors are locked when you leave parked and driving. When walking in
  urban areas, carry your personal belongings where you can see them.
- Along your route, you may encounter children running, shouting at you next to your vehicle, and asking you to stop. DO NOT STOP for these children. They want to beg for money and do not need your help. Once you've stopped, the kids crawl under your car, and continuing along your route will be difficult without giving them money first.
- When you park your car in urban areas, a person will likely approach you with the offer of
  'watching your car' while you are away. These car guards are a 'tolerated nuisance'; you will be
  expected to tip him when you return. Give no more than a N\$5 coin. Even with the 'guard'
  watching your car, do not leave any valuables visible inside the vehicle.
- Plastic bags are not permitted in national parks and NWR resorts.
- When staying at any of the NWR camps/resorts in the National Parks, you will be asked to pay a key deposit, which will be refunded when you return your room key at check-out.
- You are not allowed to take meat or animal products through the gates of the national parks.
- The gates to the National Park open at sunrise and close at sunset. Please ensure you leave the park 30 minutes before sunset.
- The speed limit inside National Parks is 60km/h please plan accordingly.
- The speed limit on national roads (B roads) is 120km/h.
- The maximum speed advised for gravel roads is 80/h.
- Driving after dark is not recommended please plan your departure time accordingly.
- Namibian traffic authorities require all non-Namibian drivers to have an International driver's
  license. You will travel through a few roadblocks where the police officer may ask to see your
  license and ask about your next destination. It is best to stay friendly; you'll soon be on your way.
- During your stay in Windhoek and Swakopmund, you may encounter street children begging
  for money. Please do not give these children money. Both cities have shelters and programs to
  assist these children.
- Your passport should be valid for at least six months after your stay in Namibia.
- Your passport should have at least two clean pages when entering Namibia.
- Tipping is discretionary and a sign of appreciation for good service. Guidelines for tipping are 10% of your restaurant bill, Euro 50 per person for your private guide, and N\$50 per person for local excursion guides.
- Many public bathrooms ask N\$2 to access the facility. Remember to carry some coins to pay for bathroom stops where necessary.
